Candidate's Statement (reproduced exactly as submitted):

I am asking for your vote in order to serve another term for the North Peninsula Service Area Board. I believe that Nikiski voters need responsible oversight of the NPSA budget and that the recreational services provided should be done as efficiently as possible.

I will work to promote efficiency and oppose unnecessary spending. I will fight for responsible spending cuts and oppose future growth, unless such growth is approved by the voters within the service area. I strongly oppose service area expansion, new tax increases, or spending on major capital projects without public votes of approval.

My solution calls for less government subsidies (currently paid for through your property tax assessments to the NPRSA), and a balanced budget through greater efficiency and limited services, rather than higher taxes.
