- <u>KPB Proposition No. 3</u>: Apportionment of the Assembly and Board of Education (Ordinance 2011-25)

- KPB Proposition No. 5: Establishing the Seldovia Recreational Service Area (Ordinance 2011-28)

The deadline to submit statements is August 19, 2011 at 5:00 p.m.

The statement submitted may not exceed 500 words.

The statement submitted to the Clerk's Office must be accompanied by a statement of interest in the proposition by the publicly recognized individual or organization.

The statement must include a signer's block located at the bottom of the statement. The signer's block must include no more than three signers. Any signers, more than the allotted three, will be considered endorsements and included in the text of the statement and counted against the 500-word limit. Signers must include the signer's full names and organizations, if any.

Signers shall sign a form prepared by the clerk indicating that the signers participated in the drafting of the statement. Forms are available at the Borough Clerk's Office at 144 N. Statements will not be released until all statements regarding the question have been received in final form and have gone to the printer.
