ALL RESIDENTS PLEASE TAKE NOTICE:

The last day to register to qualify to vote in the October 4, 2011, Kenai Peninsula Borough Regular Election is **September 2,** 2011

VOTER QUALIFICATIONS

A person is qualified to vote who:

- 1. is a citizen of the United States;
- 2. has passed his/her 18th birthday;
- 3. has been a resident of the borough for at least 30 days preceding the election;
- has registered with the State of Alaska at least 30 days before the election and is not registered to vote in another jurisdiction; and
- 5. is not disqualified under Article V of the State Constitution.

HAS YOUR NAME CHANGED?

State law requires that you must update your voter registration at least 30 days before an election in order to vote under your new name. If you have not updated your voter registration, you may vote under your previous name under which you are still registered. Voting under a name other than that on your registration record will result in your vote not being counted.

HAVE YOU MOVED?

Keep your records current. Change your registration. This is especially important if you have moved from one election district to another. Failure to re-register under your new address could prevent you from voting for candidates representing you in your new district. Contact the Borough Clerk's Office, 144 N. Binkley, Soldotna, or the City Clerk's Office in your area, to update your registration.

If you believe an error has been made regarding your precinct placement, please contact the Borough Clerk's Office or your nearest City Clerk's Office.
