That the borough shall proceed with the construction of the improvements for the Char Subdivision USAD in accordance with the provisions of KPB Resolution 2003-124, and the mayor is authorized to proceed with the construction of the improvements and to negotiate and execute such documents as are determined to be in the best interests of the borough to accomplish this project.


SECTION 4. That properties within the district are properly included and subject to assessment for the improvement.
