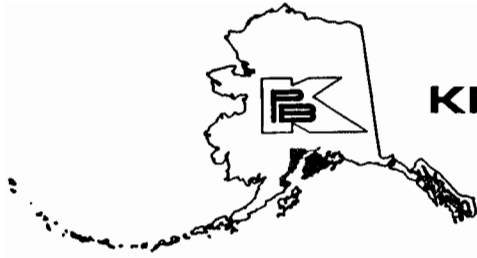

SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 2004-19-24: HUD Grant for \$745,575 for recreational facilities

The above-referenced ordinance was discussed during the Finance Committee meeting today. The Committee was informed that the projects to be funded with this HUD grant have been revised. The improvements to the ice rink in Kenai have been deleted from the HUD project list. It is expected these improvements will be funded through other revenue sources. The four projects to be funded with the HUD grant are as follows:

Icing System / Dasher Boards - Homer	\$ 397,640
Trail System Improvements – Soldotna Snow machines, groomers, signage, timing systems and trail lighting.	\$ 149,115
Scoreboards and Marquee – Soldotna Sports Center	\$ 99,410
Sporting Gear And Equipment – Boroughwide. Variety of gear and equipment for use by athletes	\$ 99,410
