## ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TERMS OF OFFICE FOR ASSEMBLYMEN

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- Section 1. ASSEMBLYMEN OUTSIDE FIRST Class CITIES. The term of office for assemblymen elected outside first class cities is hereby established at 3 years.
- Section 2. FIRST CALSS CITY APPOINTED ASSEMBLYMEN. The city councils of the first class cities and charter cities may fix the terms of office of their respective members of the assembly within the limits specified in Title 7, Alaska Statutes.
- Section 3. PUBLICATION: Publication shall be by causing a clear summary of this ordinance to be inserted one time in a newspaper of general circulation in the borough, by mailing a copy of the ordinance to the city clerk of each city in the borough with a request that it be posted on the city hall bulletin board for ten days immediately following receipt and by mailing a copy of the ordinance to each post office in the borough with the request that it be posted on the post office lobby bulletin board for ten days immediately following receipt.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sub-section, sentence or clause of this ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction the remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment.
