## ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF BOROUGH ASSEMBLYMEN AND BOROUGH CHAIRMAN

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. ASSEMBLYMEN OUTSIDE FIRST CLASS AND CHARTER CITIES AND CHAIRMEN. The term of office of borough assemblymen elected outside first class and charter cities shall be three years each and the term of office of borough chairman shall be three years; except that the term of an initial assemblyman and initial chairman shall terminate on the first Monday following the first Tuesday in October, 1966, or as soon thereafter as their successors are elected and qualify.

Section 2. CITY APPOINTED ASSEMBLYMEN. The term of office of assemblymen appointed by the city councils may be as fixed by the city councils within the limits of AS 07.20.040.

Section 3. PUBLICATION. Publication shall be by causing a clear summary of this ordinance to be inserted one time in a newspaper of general circulation in the borough, by mailing a copy of the ordinance to the city clerk of each city in the borough with a request that it be posted on the city hall bulletin board for ten days immediately following receipt and by mailing a copy of the ordinance to each post office in the borough with the request that it be posted on the post office lobby bylletin board for ten days immediately following receipt.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sub-section, sentence or clause of this ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction the remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment.
