ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH SCHOOL DISTRICT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

An emergency requiring that this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment by the assembly is declared. Emergency conditions following the earthquake preprecluded normal meetings and actions by the assembly. Obligations for personal services and other essential purposes will be in jeopardy and payments for personal services cannot be made when due unless the ordinance becomes effective before June 30, 1964.

Section 1. SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION. The sum of \$4,000 is hereby appropriated to the Borough School District to supplement the budget for the initial period January 1, 1964 to June 30, 1964.

Section 2. PUBLICATION. Publication shall be by causing a clear summary of this ordinance to be inserted one time in a newspaper of general circulation in the borough, by mailing a copy of the ordinance to the city clerk of each city in the borough with a request that it be posted on the city hall bulletin board for ten days immediately following receipt and by mailing a copy of the ordinance to each post office in the borough with the request that it be posted on the post office lobby bulletin board for ten days immediately following receipt.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sub-section, sentence or clause of this ordinance is declared invalid by a court of eompetent jurisdiction the remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
