ORDINANCE 18

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COMPOSITION OF THE BOROUGH PLANNING COMMISSION AND PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDMENT TO BOROUGH INTERIM ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 15

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 20.10.5 (a) of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) A Planning commission is hereby established consisting of the maximum number of members allowed by law. The commission shall be appointed by the assembly. Each city in the borough with a population in excess of four hundred (400) shall nominate one member of the commission who shall be a member of the planning commission of the city when an advisory planning and zoning commission has been established by the city. Other members shall be nominated by the chairman.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective thirty days after enactment.
