ORDINANCE NO. 30

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE  
ESTABLISHMENT OF A BOROUGH SEAL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA  
BOROUGH:

Section 1. Chapter 10 of Section 1 of the Code of Ordinances of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is hereby amended by adding new sections to be numbered Section 1.10.025 and Section 1.10.030 which sections read as follows:

Section 1.10.025. Establishment of Seal. The borough adopts as its corporate seal a circular device which shall have inscribed thereon, "Kenai Peninsula Borough, A Municipal Corporation, State of Alaska, January 1, 1964". The Assembly Clerk shall be the custodian of the seal.

Section 1.10.030. Uses of Seal. The corporate seal shall be affixed to all evidences of indebtedness of the borough. The assembly may, by resolution, determine such other uses for the seal as to the assembly seem appropriate.

Section 2. This ordinance becomes effective immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.
