ORDINANCE NO. 37

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

TO AMEND THE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES CONCERNING BOARD OF EQUALIZATION HEARINGS

Declaration of Emergency:

WHEREAS, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH hereby declares that an emergency exists whereby the borough Code, Section 25.05.025 states that the assembly shall meet once in each first class city in the borough which is represented on the assembly in addition to meeting at the borough seat, and

WHEREAS, the assembly will sit as a Board of Equalization within ten days from this date and there are not sufficient protests to be heard to warrant the expense and time to the borough of holding a meeting in each first class city within the borough,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

Declares that an emergency exists affecting the welfare of the people of the borough and requests the following amendment:

Section 1. Section 25.05.025 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Upon receipt of a copy of the Notice of Appeal, the assessor shall promptly prepare and deliver to the borough clerk, a record of appeal, in such form as the assembly may direct, for the use of the assembly sitting as the Board of Equalization. The record shall contain all the information shown on the assessment roll in respect of the subject matter of the appeal. Prior to the Board of Equalization hearings, the assessor shall provide administrative adjustment meetings at locations convenient to the people throughout the borough for the purpose of considering requests and questions concerning property valuations. "The assembly sitting as a Board of Equalization shall

meet at least once in each city in the borough which is represented on the borough assembly in addition to meeting at the borough seat.)

Section 2. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.
