ORDINANCE No. 43

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL  
PREFERENCES IN THE SALE OF BOROUGH  
LAND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA  
BOROUGH:

Section 1. Section 15.05.020 of the Code of Ordinances  
of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is amended to read as follows:

Section 15.05.020. Scope of Chapter. All leases,  
sales or other disposals which are made by the state  
on behalf of the borough shall be made only with the  
consent of the borough and shall be conducted in  
accordance with the Alaska Land Act (Title 38, AS) and  
the regulations promulgated by the State pursuant  
thereto, except that AS 38.05.069 shall not apply in  
the sale of borough lands. All lands which have been  
selected by the borough, and which the borough may  
wish to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of, shall be  
sold, leased or disposed of in accordance with the  
provisions of this chapter.

Section 2. This ordinance becomes effective immediately  
upon its passage and approval according to law.
