EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 59

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE PROPERTY ASSESSMENTS ACCOUNT IN ORDER TO PROVIDE WATER TO THE HOMER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. The assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough declares that an emergency exists affecting the Health and Public Welfare in that funds are immediately needed to provide uncontaminated water to the Homer Elementary School and that if such funds are not immediately forthcoming, the children and teachers of the school will remain exposed to a serious health hazard in the form of polluted water.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the General Funds of the Borough to the Property Assessments Account, the sum of \$25,000 of which \$20,000 is to be expended for the purpose of supplying uncontaminated water to the Homer Elementary School and \$5,000 shall be used as a contingency Fund for this project.


Section 3. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.
