ORDINANCE NO. 63

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH TO PROVIDE FOR A CHANGE IN THE ESTABLISHED ORDER OF BUSINESS OF THE BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AND PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONS TO THE ORDER OF BUSINESS AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Section 05.15.045 (4) of the Code of Ordinances of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is hereby amended to read as follows:

The order of business shall be:

- (A) Call to order and roll call
- (B) Opening Ceremony
- (C) Seating and Swearing in of new assemblymen
- (D) Minutes
- (E) Consideration of ordinances and any other pending actions involving public hearings.
- (F) Introduction of ordinances
- (G) Presentations by members of the public
- (H) Other business
- (I) Presentations by members of the public not on the agenda.

The order of business for any meeting of the assembly may be changed by unanimous consent of the assemblymen present and voting at the meeting. Additions to the order of business may be made at any assembly meeting by unanimous consent of the assemblymen present and voting at the meeting.

Section 2. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.
