ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH TO PROVIDE A PRODECURE FOR RECONSIDERATION OF MATTERS PREVIOUSLY REJECTED OR VETOED


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Section 05.15.040 of the Code of Ordinances of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 05.15.040. Adoption of Robert's Rules of Order. The borough assembly hereby adopts as its rules of procedure Robert's Rules of Order; except, however, that an item which has been considered and rejected by the Assembly may be re-introduced by any member no sooner than 60 days following Assembly rejection or veto by the Chairman; thereafter it may only be reintroduced following a general election.


Section 2. This ordinance becomes effective immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.
