ORDINANCE NO. 67

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A PROCEDURE
FOR RECONSIDERATION OF A PREVIOUSLY
REJECTED SERVICE AREA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA
BOROUGH:

Section 1. Section 27.10.05(f) of Chapter 10, Title 27
of the Code of Ordinances of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is
hereby amended to read as follows:

(f) Election. If the borough assembly shall by ordinance
establish a service area, the proposition wheter or not
to exercise the particular governmental power for which
the service area has been established shall be placed
on the ballot at the next general or a special election
of the borough; except, however, an area that has once
been considered and rejected by the eligible voters only
at a subsequent general election. If the ordinance es-
tablishing the service area has provided for elected
boards to supervise the furnishing of special services
in the service area, then the candidates for election
to such board shall be placed on the ballot at the
same election for election by the qualified voters re-
siding within the service area.


Section 2. This ordinance takes effect immediately
upon its passage and approval according to law.
