AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE LENGTHENING THE MINIMUM TIME FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING AND VOTE ON PROPOSED NON-EMERGENCY ORDINANCES


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Section 18.05.05 of the Code of Ordinances of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is hereby amended as follows:

Section 18.05,05. Reference is Alaska Statutes 07.20.100 and 07.20.110 for applicable provisions and authority. The requirements of AS 07.20.100 and AS 07.20.110 as they now exist and as they may be amended hereafter are hereby made a part of this Chapter by reference; except however, after the initial introduction at any regular or special meeting of the assembly of any ordinance other than an emergency ordinance, at least twenty-five (25) days shall be allowed to pass before the public hearing and assembly mote occurs. The preceeding sentence shall not be construed to affect the minumum time required for the publication of notice of the hearing on a proposed ordinance, or for other notification provided by law.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon enactment and passage according to law.
