ORDINANCE NO. 94

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE PLACEMENT  
OF IDENTIFICATION ON CERTAIN TYPES  
OF PERSONAL PROPERTY FOR ASSESSMENT  
PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA  
BOROUGH:

Section 1. CHAPTER 25.05 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough  
Code of Ordinances is amended by adding a new section to  
read:

Section 25.05.076. Identification Device Required

All persons who declare a mobile home or  
camper trailer on the personal property return  
required by Section .075 shall affix to said pro-  
perty an identification device furnished by the  
borough assessor. The assessor shall provide  
such an identification device in such form and  
style as he may determine. The device shall be  
prominently displayed on the window of or within  
one foot of the main entry door. Any person  
failing to affix, improperly removing, mutilating  
or defacing such identification device is guilty  
of a misdemeanor and is punishable by a fine of  
not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment for not  
more than 30 days.


Section 2. This ordinance takes effect thirty days  
after enactment.
