AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 05.15.
045(2) RELATING TO PLACEMENT OF
ITEMS ON THE ASSEMBLY MEETING AGENDA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA
BOROUGH:

Section 1. Section 05.15.045(2) of the Kenai Peninsula
Borough Code of Ordinances is amended to read:

(2) No item shall be considered at the regular
meeting of the borough assembly, with the exception
noted in (1) above, which has not been placed on
the agenda according to the terms of 05.15.045(1),
except that by (unanimous consent) the affirmative
vote of two thirds of the assemblymen present and
voting at the regular assembly meeting, an item
may be placed upon the agenda upon shorter notice
than that specified in Section 05.15.045(1).

Section 2. This ordinance takes effect thirty (30)
days after enactment.

ORDINANCE CERTIFICATION
