ORDINANCE 71-14

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CONTRACTS FOR GOODS OR SERVICES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Title 8 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

CHAPTER 8.05 LOCAL PURCHASE

Section 8.05.010. Local Purchase. Contracts for the purchase of goods or services shall be made with Kenai Peninsula businesses whenever possible, provided that:

- 1. Such goods or services are ordinarily sold by such business.
- 2. The business has displayed the ability to perform the requirements of the contract.
- 3. The quality of merchandise or service is equal to or superior to that available elsewhere.
- 4. The character, integrity, reputation, judgement, experience and efficiency of the business is in line with acceptable standards.
- 5. The business has the ability to provide ' maintenance or service on the goods.
- 6. Costs of the goods or services are not greater than 5% more for equal quality goods or services available from other businesses in the State of Alaska or no greater than 10% more from businesses outside the State of Alaska.
- 7. No single purchase or contract shall be made which is more than \$5,000 in excess of that available elsewhere in the State of Alaska nor more than \$10,000 in excess of that available outside the State of Alaska.

Reasonable effort shall be made to determine the availability of goods and services from Kenai Peninsula businesses. The Borough Assembly shall determine any question arising under this section.

Section 8.05.015. Definitions. In this chapter

1. "Kenai Peninsula business" means a business furnishing goods or services which has its principal place of business or headquarters located within the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

Scction 2. This ordinance takes effect 30 days after enactment.
