ORDINANCE NO. 72-25

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO  
PLANNING AND ZONING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA  
BOROUGH:

Section 1. Section 20.10.5 of the Kenai Peninsula  
Borough Code of Ordinances is amended to read:

Section 20.10.5 Planning Commission

(a) In accordance with Alaska Statutes Section  
29.33.080 as amended by FCCS SCS CSHB 208 SLA  
1972 the planning commission shall consist of  
members apportioned as follows:

- (1) Each Home Rule or First Class City shall  
have the number of seats designated in  
the following table unless a lesser number  
is approved by a resolution of the council  
of the city concerned:

<u>POPULATION</u>	<u>MEMBERS</u>
Under 4,000	1
4,001 - 6,000	2
6,001 - 8,000	3
8,001 - 12,000	4
12,001 - 20,000	5
Over 20,000	6

- (2) The area outside the Home Rule and  
First Class Cities shall have one seat  
for each two thousand (2,000) population  
or portion thereof, however, the total  
number of outside seats shall not exceed  
the total number of seats held by the Home  
Rule and First Class cities by more than  
one (1).
- (3) The planning commission may establish,  
alter or abolish, subject to approval of the  
assembly, sections for the appointment

of commissioners outside Home Rule and First Class cities, except that sections may not be abolished unless a majority of the assemblymen outside Home Rule and First Class cities approve. If sections are established the table in (1) above shall apply to each section in the same manner as to Home Rule and First Class cities.

Section 2. This ordinance takes effect thirty (30) days after enactment.
