AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DUE DATE, DELINQUENCY AND PENALTIES ON PROPERTY TAXES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Section 25.05.040 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is amended as follows:

> (d) Penalty and/or interest charges specified in item (b) of this section may be waived for good and sufficient reason. Such waiver must be approved by any two of the following:

> > Borough Mayor Director of Finance Comptroller

Failure of the taxpayer to receive a tax bill, under ordinanry circumstances, or lack of funds on the part of the taxpayer shall not be considered good and sufficient reason for waiver of penalty and interest.

Section 2. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon enactment.
