AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DUE DATE,
DELINQUENCY AND PENALTIES ON PROPERTY TAXES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Section 25.05.040 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough
Code of Ordinances is amended as follows:

- (d) Penalty and/or interest charges specified
in item (b) of this section may be waived
for good and sufficient reason. Such waiver
must be approved by any two of the following:


Borough Mayor
Director of Finance
Comptroller

Failure of the taxpayer to receive a tax bill,
under ordinary circumstances, or lack of funds
on the part of the taxpayer shall not be con-
sidered good and sufficient reason for waiver of
penalty and interest.

Section 2. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon
enactment.
