Section 1. Section 05.15.045 (4) of the Code of Ordinances of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is hereby amended to read as follows:

 - Public Presentations N.
 - 0. Informational Materials & Reports
 - P. Next Meeting

Section 2. Section 05.15.050 is repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

Sec. 05.15.050. Public Presentations. Any members of the public desiring to make a formal presentation before the borough assembly at a regular meeting shall inform the clerk of the subject he desires to present to the assembly. The assembly may limit the time allowed for individual public presentations.

Section 3. Section 05.15.055 is repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

Sec. 05.15.055. Agenda Preparation. The agenda items shall be received by the borough clerk. The borough clerk shall immediately prepare the final agenda and shall have the responsibility of sending the agenda and appropriate supplementary documents to each assemblyman as required in Sec. 05.15.045 (3).
