ORDINANCE 73-3

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES OF ASSEMBLYMEN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Sec. 05.10.015 of the Code of Ordinances of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 05.10.015 (a) Compensation of Assemblymen.
Assemblymen shall receive as compensation for meetings attended \$100.00 per month.

(b) Per Diem Allowance for Regular, Special and Work Sessions. Assemblymen, while traveling on official business to attend a regular, special or work session of the assembly, shall be allowed, instead of actual expenses for subsistence, a per diem allowance which shall be established according to the distance the assemblyman is obliged to travel to attend the meeting or perform the business as follows:

	<u>Mileage one way</u>	<u>Amount</u>
0	- 14.9 miles	\$ 25.00
15.0	- 64.9 miles	30.00
65.0	- 124.9 miles	35.00
125.0	- miles or more	50.00

In addition, the expenses of air transportation will be reimbursed at actual cost. In the event that air travel is involved, the per diem will be based on mileage from home of the assemblyman to the point of embarkation. Any meeting requiring overnight lodging will be considered as two days. Per diem shall be allowed at the rate of \$25.00 for each day in excess of the first day.

(c) Other Travel Inside or Outside the Borough. Assemblymen shall receive reimbursement for expenses occurred while travelling on official business as follows:

1) The assemblyman shall be allowed, instead of payments noted above, a per diem allowance not to exceed \$35.00 per day (this includes overnight lodging); \$15.00 for full day (without overnight lodging) and \$10.00 for one-half day.

2) In addition to per diem, expenses of travel incurred shall be allowed at the rate of 15 cents per mile for use of a privately owned vehicle.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect on the day of enactment.
