ORDINANCE 73-37

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE SCHOOL FUND FOR RESTORATION OF PREMISES AND PROPERTY DAMAGED AND DESTROYED BY VANDALISM.

WHEREAS, on June 28, 1973, certain parties broke into the Kenai Junior High School and committed acts of vandalism and destruction, and the cost of restoration of premises and property damaged and destroyed amounted to \$11,597.00; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 1973, certain parties broke into the Kenai Central High School and committed acts of vandalism and destruction, and the cost of restoration of premises and property damaged and destroyed amounted to \$150.00; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 1973, certain parties did vandalize Tyonek School by throwing rocks through the glass of windows and doors, and the cost of restoration of the premises and replacement of the glass amounted to \$2,254.00; and

WHEREAS, such senseless and destructive vandalism was not foreseen nor provided for in the maintenance area of the school fund budget, and it has been necessary to make restoration repairs immediately in order to mitigate the damages caused:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: The sum of \$14,001.00 is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated surplusses of the Kenai Peninsula Borough to the school fund to provide the necessary funds for restoration of premises and property damaged and destroyed by the above recited vandalism at Kenai Central High School, Kenai Junior High School and Tyonek School.

Section 2: This ordinance takes effect on the day of enactment.
