KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 73-54

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE THAT CONTRACTS FOR ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF DISPOSAL FACILITIES BE LET TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER .

WHEREAS, it is desirable that public contracts be let under normal bid procedures, after advertisement, to the lowest responsible bidder, and Section 14.10.030 of the Ordinances of the Kenai Peninsula Borough do not clearly specify that the contracts for establishment and maintenance of disposal facilities shall be so let;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Section 14.10.030(a) of the Ordinances of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is amended to read as follows:

- (a) Projects for the establishment, maintenance, or establishment and maintenance of disposal facilities will be advertised for bid, and contracts will be let to the lowest responsible bidder for a period of at least 3 years; this provision shall not prevent the Mayor from negotiating with a city for joint exercise of these powers so long as the negotiated agreement is approved on motion by the assembly, nor shall it prevent the Mayor from negotiating a contract on an interim basis, not to exceed 6 months, where a facility has been turned over to the borough for operation, either by another governmental entity, by abandonment of a contract, or by cancellation of a contract for default of contractor.


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Section 2. This ordinance takes effect immediately on enactment.
