BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Sec. 25.05.040(c) of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

(c) If August 15 or November 15 falls on Saturday, Sunday, or a legal holiday, the taxes normally due on such date shall be due on the next business day and shall be delinquent thereafter.

 $\underline{\text{Section }}$ 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
