KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 74-4

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE THAT HOLIDAYS TO BE RECOGNIZED BY THE BOROUGH SHALL CONFORM TO LEGAL HOLIDAYS PROVIDED FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF ALASKA .

WHEREAS, because of closures of banks and state offices on holidays provided for state employees, it is desirable to coordinate the holidays to be provided for employees of the Kenai Peninsula Borough with those provided for state employees; and

WHEREAS, because of changes from time to time in the state statutes occasions have arisen, and do now exist, where the state celebrates a holiday on one day while borough employees celebrate the same holiday on another day; and

WHEREAS, it is felt to be desirable to coordinate the holidays to be provided for employees of the Kenai Peninsula Borough with those to be provided for employees of the State of Alaska without having to amend the ordinances of the Kenai Peninsula Borough each time the statutes of the State of Alaska may be changed;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: That Section 19.05.035 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is amended to read:


Sec. 19.05.035 Holidays. The borough will recognize as legal holidays all holidays which now or hereafter may be recognized and celebrated by the State of Alaska pursuant to the provisions of AS 44.12.010, 020, and 025 and any amendments which may be subsequently made thereto.

Section 2: This ordinance shall become effective March 1, 1974.
