ORDINANCE 74-11

AN ORDINANCE TO REVISE SALARY SCHEDULES FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH TO REFLECT COST OF LIVING INCREASES .

WHEREAS, Section 19.05.135 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances was established to incorporate an automatic cost of living increase to salary schedules of borough employees based on statistical surveys made by the Division of Personnel pursuant to Alaska state law; and

WHEREAS, Alaska law was changed in 1973 to provide for negotiation of wages with employees, and subsequently no adequate statistics were collected to reflect accurately cost of living increases in the Kenai-Soldotna area; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough appointed a committee to study the local inflationary trend and to recommend adjustments in the employees' salary schedule to reflect cost of living increases; and

WHEREAS, the committee has made this study and has recommended that a cost of living increase in the amount of 9% be applied to each step in each range of the current salary schedules for borough employees (which adjustment is reflected by the schedule attached hereto) and to increase the amount of contribution to employees' retirement fund by an additional 3% of employees' wages; Now Therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Sec. 19.05.135 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is repealed and reenacted to read:

Sec. 19.05.135. (a) Salary Schedules. The salary

schedule attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein is hereby set to establish pay ranges and step positions within each range to be used in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 19.05.080 and Sec. 19.05.095 to set the salaries of employees of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 1974.
