KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 74-51

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 69-24 WHICH ORGANIZED THE NORTH KENAI FIRE SERVICE AREA FIRE DEPARTMENT TO FILL IN BLANKS WHICH WERE NOT COMPLETED ON ADOPTION OF THAT ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 69-24 was adopted on the 20th day of January, 1970, by the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, Article 5 of Section 5 of said ordinance provided a prohibition against parking any vehicle or otherwise causing any obstruction to be placed within a distance of the entrance to any fire station or other place where fire apparatus was stored, but the distance within which such parking or placing was prohibited was not filled in before adoption of the ordinance; Now Therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: Article 5 of Section 5 of Ordinance 69-24 of the ordinances of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is hereby amended to read as follows:


ARTICLE 5. No person shall park any vehicle or otherwise cause any obstruction to be placed in front of, or within 10 feet of either side of, the entrance to any fire station or other place where fire apparatus is stored, or within 10 feet of any fire hydrant or cistern.

Section 2 : This ordinance takes effect on the day of enactment.
