ORDINANCE NO. 74-62

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND MODIFYING THE VARIOUS COMPREHENSIVE
PLANS OF THE CITIES AND AREAS OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute Section 29.33.085 provides for adoption of comprehensive plans by the assembly; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive plan has been provided for the North Kenai, Kenai, Soldotna, Moose Pass, Anchor Point, Ninilchik, Cooper Landing and Hope areas in a single document; and

WHEREAS, separate comprehensive planning documents have been prepared for the Seward, Homer, Seldovia, English Bay, Tyonek and Port Graham areas; and

WHEREAS, these documents have been adopted by Kenai Peninsula Borough Resolution 72-24R; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive water and sewer study has been prepared for the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, this document has been adopted by Kenai Peninsula Borough Resolution 73-1R; and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute Section 29.48.130 and U. S. Government agencies require formal adoption of these comprehensive plans by ordinance prior to funding projects within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute Section 29.33.085 also provided for review and recommendations by the planning commission of the comprehensive plans to the assembly; and


WHEREAS, the planning commission has reviewed and recommended that the document entitled "Kenai Peninsula Borough Comprehensive Plan Goals & Objectives 1973-74" be adopted to modify the above listed plans by the assembly,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


1. That the above listed comprehensive plans be adopted as the comprehensive plans of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

2. That the document entitled "Kenai Peninsula Borough Comprehensive Plan Goals & Objectives 1973-74" modify these plans and be adopted as part of the comprehensive plans of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 74-63

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE
CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND.

WHEREAS, two oil companies paid portions of their 1973 taxes, totalling \$228,612, under protest based on contest of constitutionality of the taxation raised in the Amerada-Hess suit against the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the amount of \$228,612 was thereupon placed in a restricted fund by the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough in order to make repayment of said taxes as such became necessary; and

WHEREAS, the sum of \$230,000 was likewise placed in a restricted fund by the assembly in the 1974-1975 budget in anticipation of a similar payment under protest of 1974 taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Amerada-Hess suit against the state was dismissed on settlement following the 1973 Special Session of the Legislature, and on request of the Mayor of the Kenai Peninsula Borough, the oil companies concerned have withdrawn the protests of 1973 taxes, and no protest has been filed with payments of 1974 taxes; and

WHEREAS, the restriction is no longer required or necessary to cover the above taxes, leaving \$458,612 available for appropriation; and


WHEREAS, the assembly has authorized construction of capital projects greatly in excess of appropriated available funds; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA
BOROUGH:

Section 1: The sum of \$458,612 is hereby appropriated to the
Capital Projects Fund.


Section 2: This ordinance takes effect on the day after its enactment.
