ORDINANCE 75-1

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING KPC 18.05.05 PERTAINING TO ORDINANCE PROCEDURE TO DELETE REQUIREMENT FOR 25 DAY PERIOD BETWEEN INTRODUCTION AND PUBLIC HEARING ON ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, Section 18.05.05 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances provides that at least 25 days should elapse after initial introduction of an ordinance and before the public hearing and assembly vote except in case of emergency ordinances; and

WHEREAS, this period of time is not necessary for adequate publication of the ordinance pursuant to applicable statute, and at times this provision has made an extremely awkward timing problem where matters of urgency have been brought forward but no sufficient emergency exists to allow adoption of an emergency ordinance, and particularly in budgetary and appropriation matters which often come up on relatively short notice: Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1: KPC 18.05.05 is hereby repealed.

Section 2: This ordinance shall become effective on the day after enactment.
