ORDINANCE 75-7

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND KPC 18.05.010 (e) AND KPC 18.05.010 (f) TO CORRECT AND CLARIFY SAID SUBSECTIONS AND TO DELETE PROVISIONS MADE UNNECESSARY BY STATUTE.

WHEREAS, KPC 18.05.010 sets up a form for ordinances; and

WHEREAS, subsections (e) and (f) contain provisions which are either not precisely accurate, contain phrases unnecessarily limiting the authority of the assembly, and contain statements which do not pertain to the form of an ordinance and which are unnecessary because they are merely repetitions of statutory provisions; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. KPC 18.05.010 (e) is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

- (e) If the ordinance is passed as an emergency ordinance, then a section stating emergency findings required by Alaska Statutes shall be inserted prior to the section setting the effective date.


Section 2. That KPC 18.05.010 (f) is hereby amended as follows:

- (f) The last section of the ordinance shall set the effective date of the ordinance in the following form, "This ordinance shall become effective \_\_\_\_\_" [DAYS AFTER ENACTMENT "OR "THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON THE DAY OF ENACTMENT", (AS 29.48.150 (b)). THE EMERGENCY ORDINANCE MAY BE ADOPTED,


AMENDED AND ADOPTED OR REJECTED AT THE  
MEETING AT WHICH IT IS INTRODUCED. EMERGENCY  
ORDINANCES ARE EFFECTIVE FOR 60 DAYS].

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective two days after  
enactment.
