ORDINANCE 75-13

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND KPC 27.15.030 TO REFER TO CURRENT ALASKA STATUTE WITH REFERENCE TO CREATION AND DECLARATION OF VACANCIES ON THE HOSPITAL BOARD FOR THE CENTRAL KENAI PENINSULA HOSPITAL SERVICE AREA .

WHEREAS, KPC 27.15.030 provided for creation and declaration of the assembly of vacancies on the hospital board for the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area in accordance with the then municipal code provision for creation of vacancies in the office of assemblymen and borough chairman; and

WHEREAS, the new Municipal Code repealed all of Title 7 including the section referred to, and the new Municipal Code in setting up a new section to provide for vacation and declaration of vacancy of an elected municipal office added as additional reasons for declaration of vacancy that the incumbent was mentally unable to perform the duties of the office or that the incumbent is convicted of a felony or of an offense involving a violation of his oath of office; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPC 27.15.030 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 27.15.030. Terms and Qualifications. Members of the Hospital Board shall be qualified voters of the borough who are residents of the service area. Members shall be appointed for a term of 3 years, except that the first board shall contain members appointed for lesser periods to provide for staggered terms. Vacancies on the board shall be created and shall be declared by the assembly in accordance with AS 29.23.570 [AS 07.30.060].


Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective two days after enactment.
