KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 75-24

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING RATIFICATION BY THE VOTERS OF ANY CONSTRUCTION PROJECT WHERE THE ESTIMATED COST OF CONSTRUCTION WOULD EXCEED \$1,000,000.

WHEREAS, construction projects of great expense should not be undertaken without ratification by the taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, approval of a bond authorization ordinance would indicate such taxpayer approval of the project itself, but there is at present no requirement for voter ratification of construction, either for borough purposes or within a service area, where the construction is to be financed by cash payments from tax revenues; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new title, chapter, and section to be numbered 21.10.010 which shall read as follows:

TITLE 21. PUBLIC WORKS

Chapter 10. Construction Project.

Section 21.10.010. Ratification. No contract shall be let, and no funds shall be appropriated, for any borough or service area construction project where the estimated cost of construction would exceed \$1,000,000 unless a resolution placing before the electorate a proposition authorizing said

construction shall be passed by the assembly and the proposition ratified by a majority of those voting thereon within the borough or within the service area, as appropriate, except where all or part of such construction is financed by bonding.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective the day after enactment.
