KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 75-25

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,474,000 FOR CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONS TO KENAI CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL, EAST HOMER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, SOLDOTNA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AND BOB BARTLETT SCHOOL (TYONEK) FROM PROCEEDS OF THE SALE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, at a special election held February 25, 1975, the electorate of the Kenai Peninsula Borough approved Ordinance 74-71 by which the Kenai Peninsula Borough, instead of accumulating funds for cash payment of such a project, is allowed to incur indebtedness in an amount not to exceed \$3,500,000 for the purpose of raising funds for constructing and equipping an addition to the Kenai Central High School consisting of swimming pool, an additional athletic area, an addition of eight classrooms to the educational complex, a music room, and some renovation of the present building; and

WHEREAS, at the same special election held February 25, 1975, the electorate likewise approved Ordinance 74-73, by which the Kenai Peninsula Borough is allowed to incur indebtedness in an amount not to exceed \$1,974,000 for the purpose of raising funds for constructing and equipping a six classroom addition to the East Homer Elementary School (\$611,000), an eight classroom addition to the Soldotna Elementary School (\$812,000), and an addition to the Bob Bartlett (Tyonek) School (\$551,000); Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. The sum of \$3,500,000 is hereby appropriated to the capital project fund from the proceeds of the sale of bonds of the

Kenai Peninsula Borough for constructing and equipping an addition to the Kenai Central High School consisting of a swimming pool, an additional athletic area, an addition of eight classrooms to the educational complex, a music room, and some renovation of the present building.


Section 2. The sum of \$611,000 is hereby appropriated to the capital project fund from the proceeds of the sale of bonds of the Kenai Peninsula Borough for constructing and equipping a six classroom addition to the East Homer Elementary School.

Section 3. The sum of \$812,000 is hereby appropriated to the capital project fund from the proceeds of the sale of bonds of the Kenai Peninsula Borough for constructing and equipping an eight classroom addition to the Soldotna Elementary School.


Section 4. The sum of \$551,000 is hereby appropriated to the capital project fund from the proceeds of the sale of bonds of the Kenai Peninsula Borough for constructing and equipping an addition to the Bob Bartlett School (Tyonek).

Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective on the day after its enactment.
