ORDINANCE 75-26

AN ORDINANCE FOR REPEAL OF KPC 25.10 PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF A SALES TAX OF 3% WITHIN THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH TO BE USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR BOROUGH SCHOOL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the present sales tax and its various provisions are too burdensome for the people of the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the borough schools can be supported by taxes on real and personal property without the necessity of a sales tax levy; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPC 25.10 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective at midnight, June 30, 1975.
