ORDINANCE 75-61

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$190,000 FOR ARCHITECTURAL FEES AND RELATED EXPENSES IN ORDER TO PROCEED THROUGH THE CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS AND BIDDING PHASES OF THE NEW SEWARD HIGH SCHOOL PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough have authorized a bond issue in the amount of \$8,000,000 towards the constructing and equipping of a New Seward High School by their vote of October 7, 1975, which bonds have not been issued as yet; and

WHEREAS, there has been previously appropriated \$140,000; and

WHEREAS, the cost of architectural services, soil tests, surveys, and other attendant costs will be approximately \$330,000 to bring the project through the construction documents and bidding phase; and

WHEREAS, the funds hereby appropriated for continuing the project will be repaid from the funds received from the issuing of the bonds; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: The sum of \$190,000 is hereby appropriated to the capital projects fund to be used for the New Seward High School architectural fees and related expenses up through the bidding phase.

Section 2. This ordinance takes effect on the day after its enactment.
