ORDINANCE 76-6

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE SOLID WASTE PROGRAM FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS AND FOR OPERATIONAL EXPENSES.

WHEREAS, unexpected cost increases in operations of the Solid Waste Program have occurred (due to payment of expenses incurred during the previous fiscal year, payment of funds for fire control at the Seldovia Landfill, and the re-bid of certain contracts which were not awarded until after the commencement of the current fiscal year and required operational expense until such award) which leave insufficient funds for the operation of the solid waste program for the balance of the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, unplanned capital expenditures have been necessitated for box covers for 40 cubic yard boxes and for fencing and site preparation for the Sterling Special Waste Site and require a supplemental appropriation for capital projects for the financing thereof; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: The sum of \$27,000 is hereby appropriated to General Government Operations, Department of Planning, Fees and



Services Account from unappropriated surplusses of the Kenai Peninsula Borough for operation expenses of the Solid Waste Program during Fiscal Year 1975-1976.


Section 2: The sum of \$11,000 is hereby appropriated to Capital Projects for use in the Solid Waste Program from unappropriated surplusses of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

Section 3: This ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.
