AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO CAPITAL PROJECTS TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITION TO BOB BARTLETT SCHOOL AT TYONEK.


WHEREAS, due to lack of preliminary engineering and faulty cost estimates on the addition to Bob Bartlett School at Tyonek prior to fixing of the amount of funds to be raised by bonds and due to subsequent increase in space requirements, insufficient funding has been appropriated for construction costs, including architectural fees and equipment, for said school addition; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1: The sum of \$ 70,000 is hereby appropriated to Capital Projects from unappropriated surplusses of the Kenai Peninsula Borough to be applied on construction and related costs of the Addition to Bob Bartlett School at Tyonek.

Section 2: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
