KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 76-9

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$240,000 TO CAPITAL PROJECTS FROM THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND FOR CONSTRUCTION ON THE BOROUGH OFFICE BUILDING OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to expand borough offices to the unfinished third floor of the borough building or, in the alternative, to move the administrative offices of the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District to the third floor; and

WHEREAS, AS 35.10.015 requires that construction of public facilities by political subdivisions of the state are accessible to, and usable by, the physically handicapped, which with respect to the third floor of the borough headquarters building would require an installation of an elevator; and

WHEREAS, there may be other federal or state requirements that must be met in completing said third floor; and

WHEREAS, there are moneys available in federal revenue sharing trust fund which could be used toward construction of these facilities, including architectural or engineering planning therefor;



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. The amount of \$240,000 is hereby appropriated to Capital Projects from the Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund for construction on the borough office building including architectural and engineering fees for drafting plans, construction of an elevator to serve all three floors of the borough building, completion of the third floor, installing a data processing room on the first floor, remodeling of the second floor, bringing the building into compliance with all federal and state health and safety requirements, and any other related costs.


Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective on the day of enactment.
