ORDINANCE 76-15

AN ORDINANCE ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION "H" TO K.P.B.
1.12.020 PROVIDING THAT EACH REGULAR ORDINANCE AT INTRODUCTION
MUST HAVE ATTACHED A DATA SHEET SHOWING PROJECTED
ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS OF THE ORDINANCE, WHOM IT WILL AFFECT,
AND HOW.

WHEREAS, it is proper and necessary for the assembly
to require as much information as possible in order to act in an
informed manner upon ordinances; and

WHEREAS, an evaluation of administrative costs is a
matter of major concern in implementing ordinances, so that the
assembly may fulfill its obligation of fiscal responsibility; and

WHEREAS, information should be available as to how any
proposed ordinance will affect the citizenry and different groups
and classes of that citizenry; and

WHEREAS, such information is not always provided, and
when it is, it is usually of rather an informal nature; and

WHEREAS, the requiring such informational data sheet would
provoke more thought in preparing and introducing ordinances and
would aid in exposing unnecessary, unworkable, and unrealistic
ordinances to the assembly; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Kenai Peninsula Borough
Ordinance 76-15
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
Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new subsection H, to be numbered 1.12.020 H, which shall read as follows:

"1.12.020 H. Informational data sheet. At introduction, any ordinance, except an emergency ordinance, shall have attached an informational data sheet, prepared by the introducing authority, showing:

- A) The projected additional administrative cost of the ordinance; and
- B) An evaluation of the individuals, groups or entities that the ordinance will affect, and what that effect will be."

Section 2. This ordinance takes effect on the day after its enactment.
