KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 76-16

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS TO THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT OF \$30,000 FOR MATCHING OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF IMPACT PLANNING FUNDS.

WHEREAS, there is in excess of \$30,000 in unappropriated funds; and

WHEREAS, an application has been made with the Division of Community Planning, Department of Community and Regional Affairs, for \$60,000 in matching funds for Outer Continental Shelf Impact Planning; and

WHEREAS, said \$60,000 is available to the Borough only through a matching fund by the Borough of \$30,000; and

WHEREAS, if the matching funds are received, a total of \$90,000 will be available for assimilating basic growth information, aerial photography of populated areas, updating zoning and regulatory devices, and estimating costs of additional community services, all relating to offshore oil development; and


WHEREAS, the necessity of such information in view of possible outer continental shelf development is essential to the Borough; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. The sum of \$90,000 is hereby appropriated to the Planning Department for Outer Continental Shelf Impact Planning.

Section 2. This ordinance takes effect on the day after enactment.
