ORDINANCE 76-18

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT OF BOROUGH ATTORNEY  
BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough that the Borough will be better served if the principal executive officer of the Department of Law, known as the Borough Attorney, were appointed by the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough rather than by the Mayor; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. KPB 2.32.010 is hereby amended as follows:

"There is established a legal department in the executive branch of the Kenai Peninsula Borough. The principal executive officer of the department shall be the borough attorney and he shall be appointed by the assembly [ ,AND UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE MAYOR]."

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
