ORDINANCE 76-21

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND REENACT KPB 2.08.120 TO MAKE ITEM N. PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS, ITEM F. OF THE ORDER OF BUSINESS OF THE BOROUGH ASSEMBLY.

WHEREAS, the order of business of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly contains two provisions for public presentations, those being items H and N; and

WHEREAS, due to the size of the borough many of our constituents must travel a considerable distance in order to be present at assembly meetings; and

WHEREAS, during a substantial portion of the year the climate and roads are not conducive to traveling, especially late at night; and

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to our representative form of government to take counsel with our constituents before considering the matters which come before us; and

WHEREAS, due to the length of some of the assembly meetings it would greatly encourage public presentations if said presentations could be conducted early on in the evening; and

WHEREAS, the public tends to feel their counsel with the assembly under the present agenda is useless in view of the fact that

the assembly has already made its decisions concerning ordinances and other borough business; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

That KPB 2.08.120 is hereby repealed and reenacted as follows:

- M. Other business;
- N. Assembly and mayor's comments and discussion;
- O. Informational materials and reports;
- P. Next meeting. "

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective the day after its enactment.

2.08.130 Public presentations--Requirements. Any member of the public desiring to make a formal presentation before the borough assembly at a regular meeting shall inform the clerk of the subject he desires to present to the assembly. 2.08.140 Agenda--Preparation procedure--Borough clerk responsibilities. The agenda items shall be received by the borough clerk. The borough clerk shall immediately prepare the final agenda and shall have the responsibility of sending the agenda and appropriate supplementary documents to each assemblyman as required in Section 2.08.110.
