ORDINANCE 76-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KPB 1.12.010 PROVIDING FOR HEARING OF AN ORDINANCE FIVE DAYS AFTER PUBLICATION, BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF THE ASSEMBLY AT INTRODUCTION.

WHEREAS, KPB 1.12.010 now provides that from introduction to public hearing at least 25 days must elapse; and

WHEREAS, AS 29.48.150 provides that an ordinance may be introduced with the public hearing to be at any time following at least 5 days from the date of publication; and

WHEREAS, the assembly has from time to time the need to react to an ordinance in less than 25 days; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment provides that a shorter time may not be used without a concurrence of at least two-thirds of the members voting at the meeting; and

WHEREAS, this amendment would provide for the immediate and efficient administration of the borough through its ordinances as the situation may demand; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

That KPB 1.12.010 is hereby amended as follows:


Section 1. "1.12.010 Statutory Authority. Reference is AS 29.48.130 through AS 29.48.180 'Municipal Enactments' for applicable provisions of authority. The requirements of AS 29.48.150 and AS 29.48.160 as they now exist and as they may be amended hereafter are made a part of this chapter by reference; except however, after the initial introduction at any regular or special meeting of the assembly of an ordinance other than an emergency ordinance, at least 25 days shall be allowed to pass before the public hearing and assembly vote occurs. Except that by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the authorized vote, an ordinance may be introduced and set for public hearing not less than 5 days after publication. In no event shall the requirements for publication or any other notice of hearing required by law be violated."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect on the day of its enactment.
