ORDINANCE 76-28

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$303,500 FROM SURPLUS OF THE BOROUGH TO THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND FOR RENOVATION OF HOMER JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has adopted a continuing program of capital improvements; and


WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough has authorized the renovation of the Homer Junior High School,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. The sum of \$303,500 is hereby appropriated to the Capital Projects Fund from surplus funds of the borough for renovation of the Homer Junior High School.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective the day after enactment.
