KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 76-33

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MAYOR'S SALARY AND SALARY ADJUSTMENT ACCORDING TO THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX.

WHEREAS, KPB 2.04.060 may be in conflict with state law;  
and

WHEREAS, the assembly is desirous of establishing an impartial method of providing for increases in the Mayor's salary; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance would carry out the assembly's original intent in KPB 2.04.060; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances 2.04.060 be repealed and reenacted as follows:

- a.) Compensation for the Borough Mayor shall be \$33,000 per year.
- b.) The Mayor's salary shall be adjusted at the end of each term of office according to a cost of living adjustment equal to the percentage change in the National Consumer Price Index (C.P.I. published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U. S. Department of Labor) during said term of office.
- c.) The adjustment shall be calculated on a base of 100 for the year 1967, when adjusted by the

Consumer Price Index amounted to 138.5 in December, 1973. The salary will be thereafter adjusted to reflect the C.P.I. percentage change from December, 1973 through December of the year immediately preceding the end of the term of office. The adjustment will become effective on the date of signing the oath of office.


Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 1976.
