ORDINANCE 76-42

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$3,500 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED RESERVES TO SOLID WASTE FOR CLEAN UP OF THE SCOUT LAKE LOOP DUMP.

WHEREAS, there exists an old dump site on Scout Lake Loop Road in the Kenai Recording District, T5N, R9W of the S.M. in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 14 otherwise known as the Scout Lake Loop Dump; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the North 1/2 of said parcel while still owned by the State of Alaska was authorized by the Borough Planning Department for use as a dump site and is now privately owned; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the South 1/2 of said parcel was also authorized as a dump site, which land is now borough selected land, but which the borough has not received title; and

WHEREAS, the dump site is polluting a small stream which flows into the Kenai River; and

WHEREAS, the old dump site is unsightly and should be covered with earth in order to make the land more aesthetically pleasing and prevent pollution; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That \$3,500 of unappropriated reserves be appropriated to the Planning Department, Account #01-30-17-39009 for the restoration of the Scout Lake Loop Dump.
